



Limburg Biennale 2026

It is with great pleasure, that Odapark and Marres present the fourth edition of the *Limburg Biennale*, an exhibition that connects the professional with the amateur arts, offering a cross-section of visual art in Limburg and the surrounding region.

The three previous editions of the *Limburg Biennale* proved to be real crowd pleasers. For many participants, the group exhibition boosted their careers and enriched their portfolios.

Open Call

Marres and Odapark issued an open call for the most popular summer exhibition in Limburg, open to anyone who feels like an artist: young and old, established and unknown, from individual to collective.

Jury

The jury and curator team, consisting of 20 professional artists, reviewed the submissions without knowing who created the artworks. During a careful process, the jury selected 350 works from more than 2,500 submissions. They then used their selection to set up a space at Marres or Odapark, where they also show their own work. The jury includes members from Limburg and beyond.
